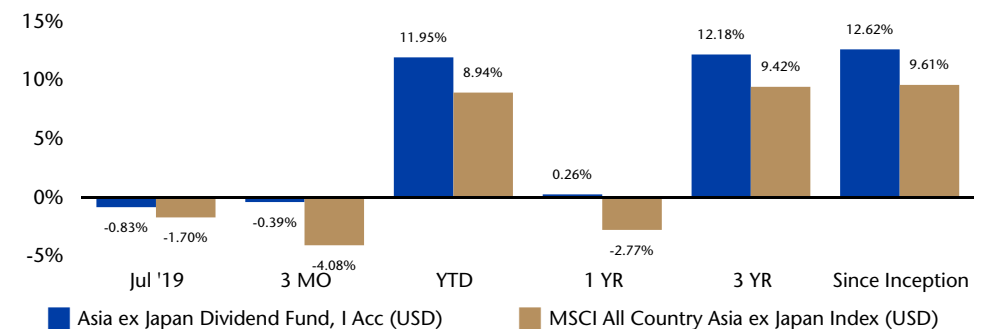
Investment Objective

Seeks to achieve total return with an emphasis on providing current income.
