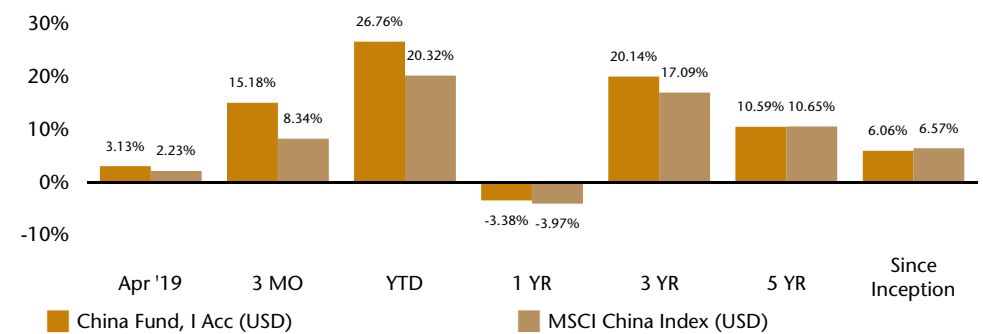
## Investment Objective
