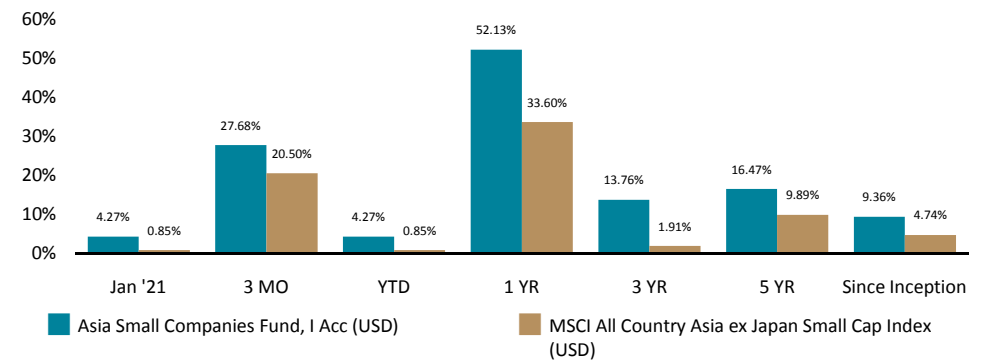
Investment Objective
