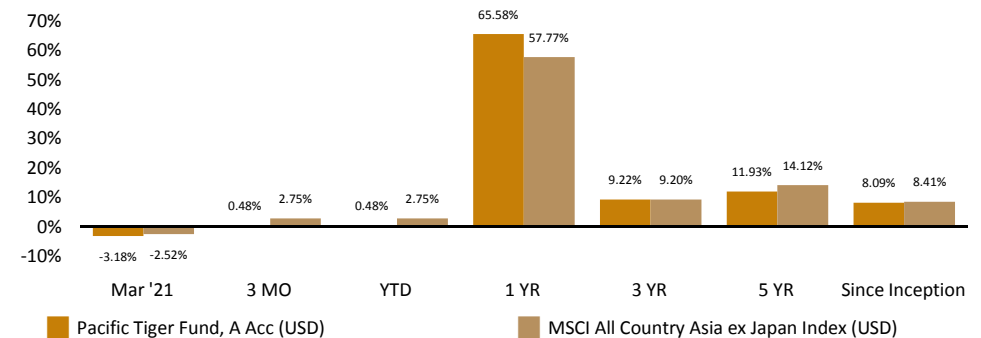
Investment Objective
